Texas Water Nonprofits

These other water-focused nonprofits are not associations (which we define as member-based organizations). These include the following organizations (note that this list is not exhaustive and that many other nonprofits work in the water space but are not solely focused on water and do not have a water-focused name):

- Texas Water Foundation: working to lead Texas into a sustainable water future by investing in the next generation of water leaders, equipping decision makers, and inviting every Texan to recognize that Texas Runs on Water.
- Texas Water Trade: a vision of durable, long-lasting water supplies in Texas that ensure future economic growth, ecological resilience and abundant water for present and future generations, no matter their income or zip code.
- Texas Water Mission: supports communities in need by providing safe drinking water and hygiene solutions.
- Texas Living Waters: a collaboration of conservation groups (National Wildlife Federation, The Nature Conservancy, Sierra Club – Lone Star Chapter, Hill Country Alliance, and Galveston Bay Foundation) working to ensure that Texas has the water it needs for thriving communities and healthy fish and wildlife.
- Texans for Clean Water: a statewide group of business leaders, industries, and NGOs with a common initiative to prevent and remove waterborne litter.
- Texas Water Action Collaborative: Facilitated by Texan by Nature, TxWAC builds collaborative relationships to align goals, metrics, and project/funding timelines between conservation organizations, corporate entities, and communities to accelerate investments that benefit water.

The **Water Conservation Advisory Council** was created by the legislature "to establish a professional forum for the continuing development of water conservation resources, expertise, and progress evaluation of the highest quality for the benefit of Texas — its state leadership, regional and local governments, and general public." It is a council of experts only, supported by TWDB.

Finally, **Texas Water** is a joint initiative of TAWWA and WEAT, in its 28th year as the largest regional water conference in the U.S. It caters to professionals in the wastewater and water industry, including water quality engineers, treatment plant technicians, scientists, government officials, regulatory agency personnel, manufacturers and their agents, libraries, universities and groups and individuals concerned with protecting public health and the environment.
